5.3.7 Designation of Permanent Access Points/Bank Stabilization

The City of San Marcos has completed the construction of bank stabilization/access points at seven locations along the San Marcos River.

Long-term Objective: Maintain integrity of structures and control erosion in the recreation traffic areas at each structure.

Target 2015 Performance Measure: TPWD inspected all access points and recommended modifications to stabilize them. Design plans will be completed and approved by TPWD for construction in 2016. Establish hard surface, fence or plants as needed to control erosion around bank stabilization/access structures and conduct an annual inspection of each structure above and below the water line.

Methods/Monitoring. See above.
