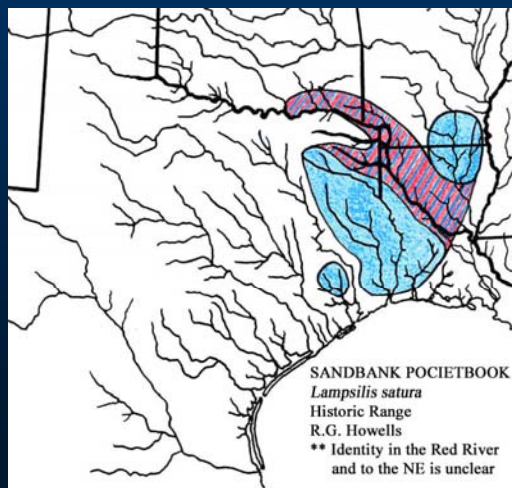
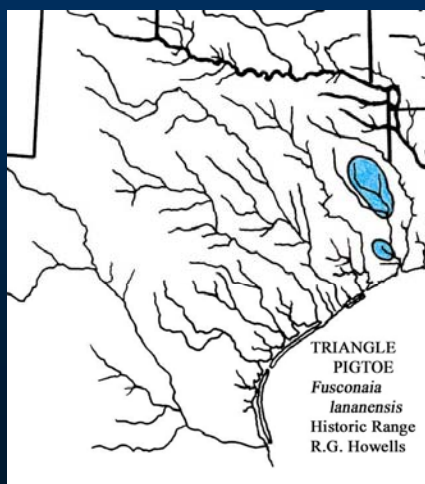
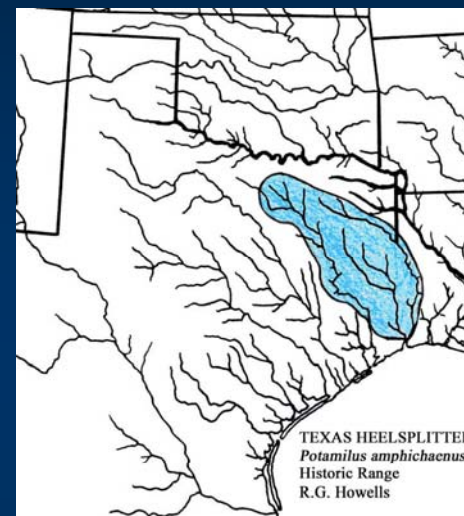
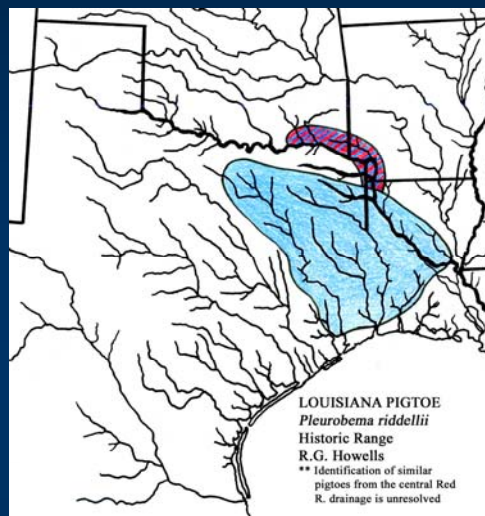
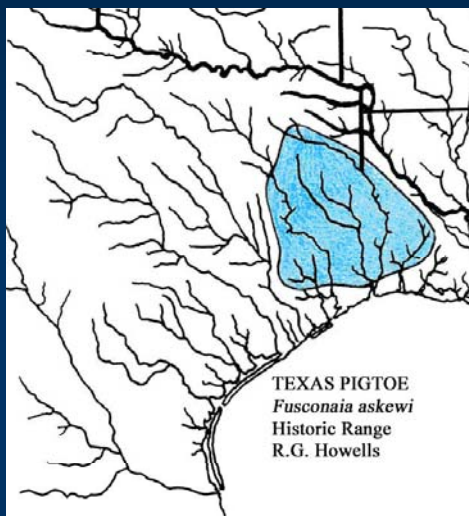
- Threatened species are those:
