

**Expert Science Subcommittee Recommendation to Add Doyle Mosier
to Replace Robert Edwards on the Subcommittee**

Doyle Mosier, aquatic biologist with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, manages the Rivers Studies Program of the Inland Fisheries Division at TPWD. His work includes addressing water quality and water quantity issues affecting fish and wildlife including instream flows. Prior to working at TPWD, Doyle worked at TCEQ and LCRA. At TCEQ he was the agency lead on technical and permitting issues for both instream flows and freshwater inflows. While at the LCRA Doyle co-authored the instream flow study for the Lower Colorado River and the freshwater inflow study for Matagorda Bay. He is also a member of the Barton Springs Salamander Recovery Team and has done habitat work on the fountain darter. In particular, Doyle's knowledge of aquatic ecology and his instream flows experience will be an asset to the EARIP Expert Science Subcommittee.
